## Date

September 20, 2025 (Saturday)

## Place

The competition will take place **in the city of Kaunas** [near the Darius and Girėnas Stadium](#)

## Map and terrain

“Kaunas”

Compiled in 2025

Map scale: 1:12,000

Contour interval: 2.5 m

Map size: SRA3 (320 mm x 450 mm)

The map contains a total of 33 control points.

## Event format

Orienteering on foot in teams of two, collecting control points (CPs) in a self-chosen order within a time limit (1 hour or 2 hours).

## Program

September 20 (Saturday)	
8:00 - 9:30	Arrival and registration at the event center
9:45	Teams are called to the start area (for the 1-hour and 2-hour courses)
10:00	Mass start for all participants
11:00	Finish time for 1-hour course
12:00	Finish time for 2-hour course
16:00	Award ceremony

## Map distribution

Maps are issued to teams when collecting the starter packs at the competition centre.

Teams are allowed unlimited time to plan their routes.

## Starting procedure

Teams must start from the start area, passing through the arch at the start time.

Participation is open to all, **except citizens of the Russian Federation and Belarus.**

## Time limit

**60 or 120 minutes**, depending on the selected course.

## Time keeping

The SPORTident AIR+ electronic punching system will be used. Traditional SPORTident cards may also be used. Participants who do not own a card may rent one from the event secretary.

**Rental fee: 2 EUR.**

Lost cards must be reimbursed at the current market price.

## Entry fees

Participation is free of charge.

## Determining the winners

- The team with the highest total points wins.
- If teams have the same number of points, the higher place is awarded to the team that finished faster.

- **For each exceeded minute – 10 points are deducted.**
- Both team members must reach each control point together.
- The maximum distance between team members is 100 meters.
- **The value of a control point is calculated by multiplying the first digit of the control point number by 10. For example, CP 76 is worth 70 points, while CP 31 is worth 30 points.**

## Important!

If you cannot find a control point (CP) in the field, which may have been stolen, incorrectly placed, or is not functioning, you must send an SMS to the help phone number indicated on the map, including the CP number and your team number. Only in this case will the missing CP be credited to you. SMS messages are valid only for control points that are missing from their designated location or are not working. If the control point is in place but you simply did not find it, the SMS is not valid and points will not be awarded.

**Incorrect ways to report a missing CP include: calling the help phone, sending a photo, or using Facebook Messenger.**

## Important!

Streets that must not be crossed anywhere and where riding/walking/running is strictly prohibited are marked with a special sign. These streets may only be crossed at designated locations (red brackets). Trails or paths

running alongside these streets may be used for riding/walking/running. The organizers have the right to disqualify teams that do not follow the rules.



## Awards

The top 3 teams in each group will receive OS Festival souvenirs, prizes, and medals.

Only athletes present at the awards ceremony will receive prizes.

If fewer than 3 teams are registered in a group, only the winner (1st place) will be awarded.

## Required equipments

### Mandatory:

- Mobile phone
- Reflective vest or other reflective element

### Recommended:

- Compass
- Small backpack
- Timer/watch
- Ruler
- Headlamp

### Other information

- Participants are fully responsible for their own health and safety during the event.
- For students, responsibility lies with their coach or accompanying person.
- All participants must have a valid medical certificate allowing them to take part in sports competitions.
- Travel, accommodation, and meal expenses are covered by the sending organization or the athletes themselves.
- Complaints must be submitted within 1 hour of the athlete's finish time – or earlier, if possible.
- All participants must start with an official bib number provided by the organizers. Participants without a bib will be disqualified.
- By registering, participants agree that their name, surname, year of birth, team, and results will be published on the event's registration site: <http://www.dbsportas.lt>.
- Participants may be photographed, filmed, or tracked in real-time, and this material may be used to promote the event and the sport.
