

“Pažaislio šilas”

Mapped in 2024, updated in 2025

Scale: 1:7500

Contour interval: 2.5 m

The terrain offers good to very good runnability, dominated by small to medium landforms. The maximum elevation on a single slope is up to 25 meters. The network of roads and paths is very dense.

Program

17:30 – 19:00	Arrival and registration at the event center

Type of event

MV35-85 Individual, one-day orienteering foot race on a night course. MN12-23 and M/V groups will have a set time limit to collect as many controls as possible.

Age groups and participants

The competition will be held in the following age classes:

M/V, M/V 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, Open 1, Open 2

**M - women, V - men.*

Participation is open to everyone **except citizens of the Russian Federation and Belarus.**

Start procedure

In individual classes M/W and M/W 12–23, participants start with a mass start.

Other groups start with interval starts. Participants enter the start zone 3 minutes before their assigned start. Start interval is no less than 2 minutes and no more than 6 minutes. Start lists are created randomly.

Open group participants may start at any time between **20:00 and 20:30**.

Time keeping

The competition will use the SPORTident AIR+ electronic punching system. Participants may also use traditional SPORTident cards.

Participants without their own SI card can rent one on site at the event center.

Rental fee – 2 EUR.

Lost cards must be reimbursed at market value.

Registration

Registration deadline: **September 15, 2025 at 23:59**

Late registration is only possible if start slots, maps, bibs, etc., are available. Open group registration will be available on site.

Entry fees

Participation is free of charge.

Determining a winner

- MV12–23 ir M/V participants will have to collect as many controls as possible in a given time.
- If the number of controls are identical for more than one participant – person that spent less time in the course is ahead of others.
- For every minute past the set time – minus 1 point.

CP points: One control point is worth – 3 points.

Awards

Top 1 – 3 place finishers in each age group will be awarded OS Festival souvenirs, prizes and medals.

Awards are presented only to athletes who attend the award ceremony in person.

Additional information

- Participants are fully responsible for their own health and safety during the event.
- For school-aged participants, responsibility lies with their coaches or guardians.
- All participants must have a valid medical certificate allowing participation in sports competitions.
- Travel, accommodation, and meals are the responsibility of the sending organization or the participants themselves.
- Protests must be submitted within 1 hour after finishing, but preferably as soon as possible.
- All participants must compete with an official bib number provided by the organizers.
 - Participants without a bib will be disqualified.
- By registering, participants agree to the publication of their name, surname, birth year, team and results on the event's registration page (<http://www.dbsportas.lt>).
- During the event, participants may be photographed, filmed, and tracked in real-time. This material may be used for event publicity and sport promotion purposes.
